Semester 2 begins on Tuesday, January 31st.

Any Student in a Diploma Course, NEEDS to sign up for a <u>myPass</u> account.

Every student in Grades 10-12 should sign up for a myPass account.

This is how you can view Diploma Exam results, credits earned and order transcripts.

Transcripts do not come from schools. Transcripts come from Alberta Education.

To sign up, a student must provide the school office or Miss Meurs with a personal email address (other than their school email address). Once this is entered in the myPass system, you may sign up for an account. Alternatively, you may choose to receive a secure passcode from Alberta Education via regular mail. If you require assistance, please see Miss Meurs or the office.



Grade 9 Girls Zones will be held at I.C.S.



SCHOOL FEES: 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

The following fees are due before students receive text books:

Grade 9: \$104.75

(Grade 9 students do not pay additional Option Class fees.)

Grades 10/11/12: \$42.25

The Per Course fees will be invoiced on September 15th, 2022 (for Semester 1) and on February 28th, 2023 (for Semester 2).

Students who drop courses after September 30th, 2022 and February 28th, 2022, respectively, will forfeit their fee.

Any families who are experiencing financial difficulties and as such are not able to pay base school fees before classes begin, are encouraged to speak with Mr. Grimes to discuss payment plans or other options. (daniel.grimes@pallisersd.ab.ca or 403-345-3383)

Fees for the 2022/23 School will be posted to SchoolCash Online on August 19th.




