
BUT before we get too far ahead of ourselves, we have more than a quarter of a year left. Please help us keep your children on task in order to finish the year strong.



We are starting to plan for the 2024-2025 School Year at Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary. Students will be selecting their courses in April.



Any Student in a Diploma Course, NEEDS to sign up for a <u>myPass</u> account.

Every student in Grades 10-12 should sign up for a <u>myPass</u> account.

This is how you can view Diploma Exam results, credits earned and order transcripts.

Transcripts do not come from schools. Transcripts come from Alberta Education.

To sign up, a student must provide the school office or Miss Meurs with a personal email address *(other than their school email address)*. Once this is entered in the myPass system, you may sign up for an account. Alternatively, you may choose to receive a secure passcode from Alberta Education via regular mail. If you require assistance, please see Miss Meurs or the office.




