First Nations, Métis and Inuit people born in **1986 or earlier** (35 years of age and older), and those with health conditions (Phase 2B) born in 2009* or before can attend to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

*Eligible youth born between 2009 and 2006 (turning 12 - 15) will need to come with their parent/guardian, as consent is required.
