The Kate Andrews Fire and Emergency Services Academy will be hosting an information session for interested students and their parents on **May 10th @ 7:30pm in the KA Library**

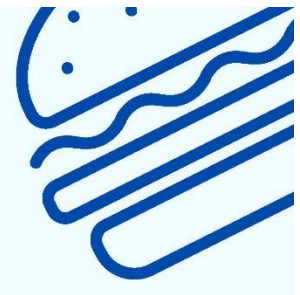
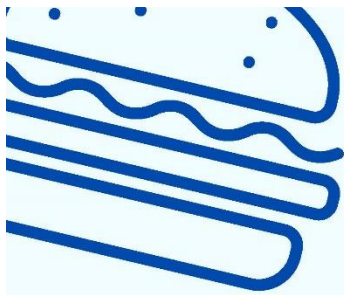

And welcomed the golden scenery of yesterday.



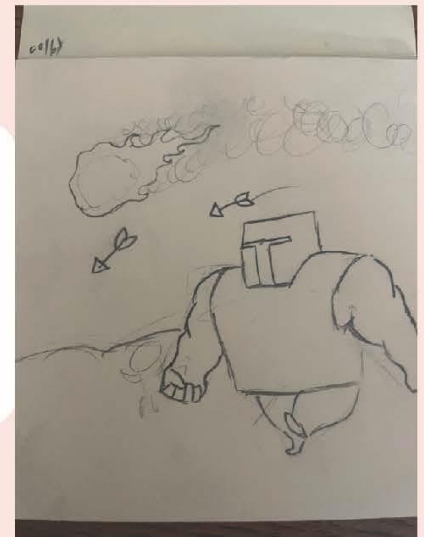

As the arrows and fireballs crash around the knight as he pushed forward for his King in glory for his Kingdom



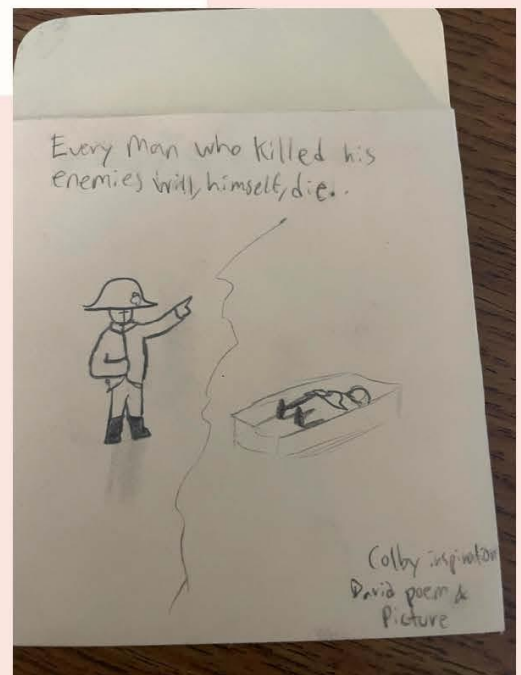
