



myPass

myPass is an Alberta Education secure self-service website for high school students to:

- ✓ View and print diploma exam results statements
- ✓ Order transcripts
- ✓ And more

Visit myPass.alberta.ca to request access.



Any Student in a Diploma Course, NEEDS to sign up for a myPass account.

Every student in Grades 10-12 should sign up for a myPass account.

This is how you can view Diploma Exam results, credits earned and order transcripts.

Transcripts do not come from schools.
 Transcripts come from Alberta Education.

To sign up, a student must provide the school office or Miss Meurs with a personal email address (*other than their school email address*). Once this is entered in the myPass system, you may sign up for an account. Alternatively, you may choose to receive a secure passcode from Alberta Education via regular mail. If you require assistance, please see Miss Meurs or the office.
