Grad Banquet Tickets will be on sale from June 3 to June 7.


All School/Textbook/Athletic fees must be paid before tickets can be purchased.




Ceremony Tickets are free however as there is limited space in the church, each graduate will be given a set number of tickets based on available space in the venue.



MAY STUDENTS OF THE MONTH














FINAL EXAMS & LAST DAY OF CLASSES

Final Exams will take place from Thursday, June 13th – Wednesday, June 26th.

Students are not required to be at school during these dates unless they have an exam. Students may make arrangements with teachers for exam help during this time, but are advised not to just show up for help without making prior arrangements, as teachers will be supervising other exams and may not be available.

The complete exam rules can be found in this newsletter, on our website, and hard copies can be picked up from the office. The schedule will be posted on the website.

SIGN UP FOR myPass!

Highschool transcripts must be obtained from Alberta Education via myPass. Highschools are not able to provide these. Please visit myPass.alberta.ca to register. You will be sent an access code via regular mail to set up your account, so it is best to do this as soon as possible.

We strongly encourage ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS to register for myPass. In a regular school year, you can also use myPass to view Diploma Exam results and view credits!

KAHS June 2024 Final Exam Rules

Students who are scheduled to write English 30-2 Part A DIPLOMA EXAMS on June 11th and Social Studies 30-1 Part A DIPLOMA EXAMS on June 12th will be excused from all classes on that day. However, they are welcome to attend afternoon classes if they are finished their exams.

ALL students scheduled to write a final exam MUST be present at the scheduled time unless prior arrangements have been made with the teacher. A student who misses an exam due to illness MUST report the illness to the office and the teacher immediately, <u>AND</u> produce written verification from his/her doctor (in the case of a Diploma exam).

Students should be in place for their exams 15 minutes prior to the exam time. Diploma exam students may NOT leave the exam room until 1 hour after the exam start time.

STUDENTS ARRIVING ONE HOUR AFTER THE EXAM START TIME WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WRITE THE EXAM.

Students who require the exam to be read to them will write in the Computer Lab or Library.

Textbook returns will be possible between 8:30 and 9:00 on each final exam day. Students should deliver their own textbooks to the BOOK ROOM before writing the subject exam the text was used for.
