

The *Per Course fees* (which apply only to Grades 10-12) for the first semester will be invoiced on September 30th, 2015 and then on February 28th for the second semester.

Students in Grades 10-12 who drop courses after September 30th, 2015 and February 28th, 2016 will forfeit their fee.
